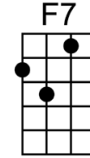
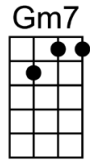


# Haole Hula (F)

I hear the crash of waves on the rocks and the beaches

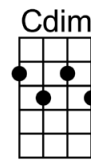
